Instructions to candidates

- Candidate should enter the examination hall 15 minutes before the start of the examination. 1.
- No candidate will be allowed to enter the examination hall beyond 30 minutes after start of the examination. 2.
- Copying in any form is a very serious offence carrying severe punishment. Do not carry any written or printed 3. matter in any form to the examination hall.
- No electronic gadgets like mobile phone, calculator and / or scientific calculator etc will be allowed in the 4. examination hall. If any electronic gadget including Mobile Phone is found in possession of any candidate during examination (even if it is switched off), the same will be confiscated and such student will be suspended for two years as circulated vide memo no COE/UHS/745 dt 23-06-2017.
- Candidates are prohibited from writing their names, registration numbers, roll numbers on any part of the 5. answer scripts except in the space provided on the title page of the answer script / additional loose sheets.
- Answers should be written on both sides of the answer script pages. The answer should be legibly written in 6. black or blue ink only. Number of lines on each page should not be less then 25.
- All rough work must be done on the right hand side leaving a margin for that purpose with the heading 7. "Rough Work".
- Do not write in the left hand margin except the question number. 8.
- Note the number of the question in the margin and also in the center of the page above the first line of each 9.
- Use separate answer scripts for answering questions of separate groups, wherever instructed. No paper 10. should be detached from the answer book.
- The responsibility to hand over the answer script to the invigilator lies with the candidate. 11.
- University observers and other University representatives are empowered to check any candidate in the 12. examination hall or outside the examination hall detecting malpractices.
- During Oral/Viva-voce/Practical Examination candidates have to carry their own Dissertation and/or Log Book (wherever applicable). Dissertation should be produced during the Oral/Viva-voce/Practical 13. Examination if asked for the examiner/s.
